Californians for Disability Rights, Inc, CDR was originally organized in 1970 with five people as CAPH (the CA Association of the Physically Handicapped) -- with 5 members. It now has members statewide. CDR has grown to become an effective and widely respected cross-disability organization of people with disabilities in CA. By 1981, they had succeeded in getting 68 laws passed that set up the access codes for Title 24 building codes, and put many other important disability laws in place.

CDR maintains a Capitol presence to create awareness of disability issues statewide.
