Californians for Disability Rights, Inc., CDR, was originally organized in 1970 with five members from L.A. and Sacramento as CAPH (the California Association of the Physically Handicapped). They worked to get the access codes into Title 24 of the CA Building Codes that made schools and public restrooms accessible, mandated curb cuts, and made programs and public accommodations accessible.

CDR now has many members and chapters statewide, and has grown to become an effective member supported and funded, widely respected, cross-disAbility organization.

Among the many accomplishments:

- ⌘ Changes in CA law to allow the use of small claims court for civil and injunctive relief in removing barriers to access in our communities (1998 AB 2702)
- ⌘ Buyers of homes just being built got a Checklist of Accessible Features (2004 AB 1400)
- ⌘ Refueling assistance (1997 AB 1277)
- ⌘ State law requiring college and university text books be available in accessible formats (1999 AB 422)
- ⌘ Parking in two spaces when no accessible spots are available (CVC Sec 22511.85)
- ⌘ Allowing disabled drivers to remain in their towed vehicle (CVC 23116(c))
