Californians for Disability Rights Inc, CDR, was originally organized in 1970 as the California Association of the Physically Handicapped; it now has members throughout the state. CDR has grown to become an effective and widely respected cross-disability organization of people with disabilities. By 1981, they succeeded in getting 68 laws passed which set up the access codes for Title 24 building codes, and put many other important disability laws in place.

CDR maintains a Capitol presence to create awareness of disability issues statewide.
